

David Hicks Overmyer painted the four Historic Farrell Library murals in 1934. Following restoration in a three-year project funded by The Friends of the K-State Libraries, the murals were professionally photographed by Ed Olson. The resulting high-quality images are now available in a variety of formats, perfect reminders for any K-State alumnus of their student days.

NOTE CARDS

Each note card set includes eight 4x6 cards, 2 of each mural, with coordinating ivory envelopes.



FRAMED PRINT

These prints are archival pigment prints using fade resistant inks on archival matte fiber paper to maximize longevity, color detail and dynamic range. The ink and paper combination has been verified by Wilhelm Research, the authority in inkjet and giclée printing. The prints are sealed with a UV filtering lacquer, mounted with PH neutral adhesive on 100 percent museum quality ragmat and secured in a wooden, charcoal stain frame. Finished size is 27"x11".
